The development association Tumaini Isiolo e.V., Hope for Kenya, supports several projects in the north of Kenya in and around the town of Isiolo.

Katrin and Jochen Heeskens lived and worked for three years (2009-2011) as development workers together with their three children in Isiolo. They want to use the existing contacts to offer direct and sustainable help. The association sees education as the main starting point for a long-term development opportunity for the local people.
